

"TIRED OF TIRES"

Project Background & Scope

The "Tired of Tires" program focuses on educating small scrap tire generators about proper scrap tire disposal options and encouraging scrap tire shipment tracking and disposal to occur in a manner consistent with practices that the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) mandates for larger scrap tire generators. By empowering small-scale scrap tire generators with the awareness of proper disposal options and how to utilize such options, we aim to significantly reduce illegal scrap tire dumping instances within the Lower Galveston Bay watershed, mitigating the adverse environmental impact.

To incentivize proper scrap tire disposal, small-scale generators which provide a completed TCEQ manifest as evidence of their scrap tire delivery to TCEQ-permitted recycling facilities will be reimbursed for their initial delivery. This not only encourages lawful practices but also ensures responsible tire disposal. The Bayou Preservation Association, through its Clean Bayous Program, will serve as project administrator.

Implementation through Action

Bayou Preservation Association seeks to transform the landscape by educating operators, promoting compliance, and guaranteeing proper tire disposal. By doing so, we safeguard our region's watershed health and vitality for future generations, leaving a lasting positive impact on our community and environment.
